

#### North Coast Priorities: Fire Rebuild

#### 4 leaf concerns

- Septic requirements
  - State requires that counties are responsible for implementing state regulation.
  - Issue: Concern that State is pushing Counties to require enhanced septic systems for water quality.
  - Meeting with Environmental Health Staff next week to discuss this issue.
  - Will urge staff, where possible by law, to not require those system for fire victims and urge for more affordable systems.



#### North Coast Priorities: Fire Rebuild

#### 4 leaf concerns

- Milling and labeling lumber
  - Issue: Need to understand whether 4 leaf is overstepping boundaries with labeling and inspecting lumber for rebuild.
- Office is in monthly fire rebuild meetings with OR3 Staff, Planning staff, Environmental Health, Public Works, 4 Leaf, and District 5.
  - Ask questions & get updates
- Need for better communications between OR3 and community.



## North Coast Priorities: Disaster Preparedness

- Long term drought
- 2020 Fires
- 2023 Storms
  - As an environmental scientist, we're living in a new normal and need to make sure County is prepared.
  - Need to support Department of Response,
     Recovery and Resiliency
  - Increased funding for infrastructure, shaded fuel breaks, education, shelter and care team, volunteer responders, among others





#### North Coast Priorities: UCSC Growth

- Lots of issues around growth
- City and County are both suing the University over the inadequacy of the EIR on the 2021 Long Range Development Plan
- The biggest attempts to get the University to legally bind itself to house all the new students on campus with increased enrollment.



Unclear when the next hearing will be.

# North Coast Priorities: North Coast Multi-Agency Working Group

 Conducting meetings over the next couple of weeks to review the list of the consultant proposed priority projects

 Once a draft Plan is agreed upon, there will be at least one meeting on the north coast to get public input.



## North Coast Priorities: County Roads

Maintaining the rural roads in my district is critical for access

 Best way to report potholes or other hazards on county roads is to use the MySantaCruzCounty app or visit the Dept. Public Works Website



 D3 receives very little discretionary dollars for roads since we have very few miles of county roads.

## North Coast Priorities: County Roads

 Keeping roads accessible during storms is important.

 Will be discussing D3 roads with Director of Community Development and Infrastructure.

## North Coast Priority: Communications


 Understand that cell service and communications are a major challenge in Bonny Doon.

 Although board has no regulatory authority over cell/internet providers, will still push for them to extend services in a manner that is safe.

 Need to ensure that redundancy and resiliency is built into these networks.

#### **Utilizing a microgrid**

Microgrids are self-contained energy systems that can be connected to the larger grid or function as an "island."
